Experiment

Materials

- flower printout (next page)
- crayons or colored pencils
- cheesy puffs
- scissors

1. **Print, color, and cut out**
your flower - see next page
2. **Place cheese puffs**
on the center of the flower.
3. **Eat the cheese puffs**
and wipe your fingers
on the center of the flower.
