Experiment

Materials

- glass jar
- empty soda can
- soil and sand
- earthworms
- spray bottle with water
- lettuce, carrots, or dog food

1. Put the empty can in the jar.
2. Layer soil and sand around the outside of the can.
3. Mix a bit of the food in top layer.
3. Spray the top layer of soil.
4. Put worms in and let them dig in.
6. Put jar in a dark place and moisten soil every few days.
7. Let worms go home in 1-2 weeks.
